

Preposition Practice





Ask each player to write a sentence that includes a preposition on their whiteboard.

For example, 'Laila went **over** the bridge.'

The player then passes their board to the next player. They must then re-write the sentence but with a new preposition.

For example, 'Laila went **under** the bridge.'

If a player can't think of a new preposition, they're out.

The winner is the last person playing.

If you are playing on your own, how many different prepositions can you fit into your sentence?

Laila went over the bridge.
