Ask each player to write a sentence that includes a preposition on their whiteboard.

*For example, 'Laila went **over** the bridge.'*

The player then passes their board to the next player. They must then re-write the sentence but with a new preposition.

*For example, 'Laila went **under** the bridge.'*

If a player can't think of a new preposition, they're out.

The winner is the last person playing.
